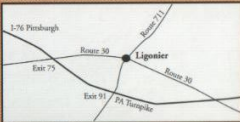

**NO PETS PLEASE!!!** and remember to follow the signs to designated parking lots.

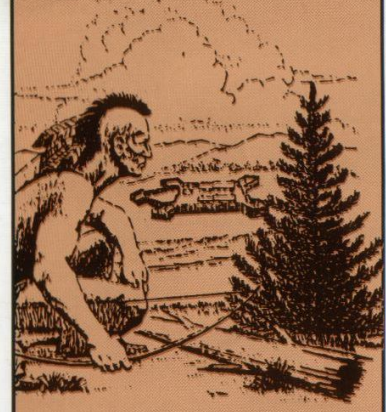
### Location:

### Fort Ligonier Days,

a very popular 3-day festival, commemorates the Battle of Fort Ligonier, key engagement of the French and Indian War, fought on October 12, 1758.

On the grounds of the Fort you will find a living history encampment showing frontier life, military tactics, drills, cannon, ceremonies, Highlanders, redcoats, French troops, frontiersmen



and women, Indians and music from 1758. In 2008, Fort Ligonier will commemorate the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of its' construction (September), the Battle of Loyalhanna (October 12) and General John Forbes and Colonel George Washington at Loyalhanna (November).

A favorite at the Fort is the re-enactment of the Battle of Fort Ligonier at 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. See artillery demonstrations at 1:30 and 3:30 p.m.

### Activities throughout Ligonier include:

- Ligonier Merchant's sidewalk sales
- Interesting and colorful antique window displays (prizes awarded)
- Dozens of community food booths on the Diamond and throughout town offer a variety that will satisfy the hungriest of appetites (open 9:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday, 12:00 Noon Sunday).
- "Sit-down" meals are available at several local churches. (please see festival program)
- Approximately 150 craft booths in three locations are linked by shuttle service – Mellon Park, the Municipal Parking Lot, Loyalhanna Parking Lot (Friday and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday 12:00 Noon to 5:00 p.m.)
- Talented artisans display and sell their wares including: pewter figures, wicker and wood, dolls, dried flowers, painting and prints, stained glass, jewelry, leather, baskets, pottery, blacksmithing

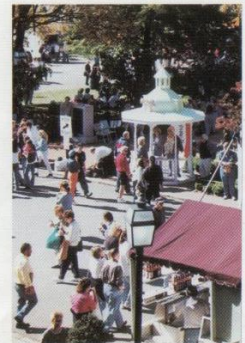


A large community parade, ranked one of the best in Western PA, winds its way down Main Street around Ligonier's picturesque Diamond at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday. It features

bands, floats, antique cars, Indian and Colonial units, and much more!

Free outdoor entertainment includes something for everyone – Saturday Night oldies

concert, folk music, bagpipes and drums, foot-stompin' bluegrass, hymns and gospel tunes, and country-rock. (Please refer to the festival program for times and locations.)
